FOOD/CAR MONEY: \$40 to be paid to the **Troop** by Sept. 7th.
IMPORTANT NOTE: Each Scout who needs a ride is responsible to ask an adult **prior** to the trip. The Troop would like all Scouts to have an idea what car they are in, to save time on Friday night.

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IMPORTANT NOTES:

- **All Scouts whose parent is not driving MUST pay the Transportation Fee to the Troop. It will be distributed among the drivers that drive scouts other than their own and/or equipment.** Please **do not pay a driver directly. Non driving adults need to pay this fee as well.**
- Troop 137 does not arrange transportation to and from events. This is the responsibility of each Scout. Each Scout is responsible to ask an adult if he can get a ride **prior** to the trip. Prior to the trip, the Troop would like all Scouts to have an idea what car they are in, to save time on Friday night. Scouts have the Troop Roster form with all of the phone numbers. We are trying to minimize the number of cars in camp. Three to four Scouts per sedan or five to six Scouts per minivan are optimal. **When the Scouts arrive at the BANK SIDE of the 7/11 meeting place they should have their transportation settled.**
- Every driver must have a valid driver's license and insurance coverage per BSA policy.
- The Troop will have the trailer available for troop equipment and backpacks.
- To minimize driving, parents providing transportation are welcome to stay with the Troop. Please check with the Adult Leader in charge of the event to determine if the Troop needs your assistance in driving Scouts and/or equipment.
- Youth Cell Phones and Youth Entertainment Electronics are NOT allowed at the event.
